RVH met with Robin Hohweiler of the PI&PM, Laurie Steenbergen of the WWAT, and Sarah Eckhart of Main Street to do a year at a glance and planned all of the events for the year. We are starting to meet on the Drone Festival which will be held at the County Event Center. The Red Dirt Showdown will be in May for its second year. It brings a number of people from all over the nation to Woodward. They will be changing the area where the drag race will be this year. We have also been working on the disc golf project that will be here behind the conference center. The whole project has been under budget. The Disc Golf organization received a commitment from CF Industries to help with sponsorship of the park. This area will eventually be a nature walk as well as a hummingbird watch area. The Disc Golf course is expected to be open by the middle of March. RVH is still uploading locations to the Film Friendly program. RVH was notified that we were chosen first for the Lieutenant Governor's Tourism Summit. The WWAT is planning a ceremony for the Temple Houston Historical Marker that will talk about the historical significance of that region of town. Fort Supply will be handed over to the OHS, and has been put in place for funding to keep it a historical location. That funding will go to fix the roof problems, as well as other issues around the location.
