City Manager Alan Riffel announced today that through traffic on 34th Street will be shut down on Monday, August 13th, for construction to begin on the bridge crossing for Experiment Lake. This is the first phase of the two-mile road project between Oklahoma Avenue and Hank's Trail, which is scheduled for a 12-month completion.

"This project is finally ready to kick off and will be a major improvement to our traffic flow for that side of town when it is finished. There will be some inconvenience during construction, but the result will be a fabulous new corridor that resolves troublesome congestion issues at certain times of the day," Riffel said.

The City of Woodward is partnering with the Oklahoma Department of Transportation on the project. The Cummins Construction Company, of Enid, is the primary contractor for the project.
